RESEARCH PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

The research proposal is an important attachment to the application documents. It is one of the major bases for selection and will somehow reflect the applicant's readiness to carry out a research work. The topic of interest should fall under the following areas:

Rural Development

- GAP Promotion and Adoption: Issues and Constraints
- Determinants of GAP Adoption (in specific vegetable crop)
- Effectiveness of GAP in Production and Marketing (of specific vegetable crop)
- Benefits of Contract Farming to Small Farmers
- Enhancing the Efficiency and Competitiveness of Value Chain (fruits or vegetables)
- Linking Small Farmers to Modern Markets: Strategies and Best Practices

Trade and Investment Facilitation

- Free Trade Agreements utilization by SMEs- status, issues and challenges
- SME (specific product) export market competitiveness- challenges and prospects
- SME awareness of AEC 2015
- Impact study of an Economic Corridor on trade development;

Human Migration

- Ease of Doing Business in Myanmar
- Assessment of Skilled Labor Demand and Supply in Myanmar
- Factors Affecting Low enrollment in technical and vocational education training (TVET).

During the scholar's one-month stay in MI, he/she will have ample opportunities to further develop the research proposal under the technical guidance of MI-designated adviser.

Outline for the Research Proposal

1. Background information (one-page)

- Your name, educational background, country, and employment history (if any)
- A clear statement on why you want to apply for MINZAS (about 150 words)

2. Research Proposal

- Title of the Research
- Provide a short introduction/background/rationale
- Indicate the research objective/s
- Include a brief methodology and summarize the major activities and time frame (Gantt chart)

Important: In formulating your research proposal, please make sure that the area you want to pursue is included in the list mentioned above.
